## Moses Parts the Red Sea

### LESSON POINTS

#### Bible Story: Red Sea

#### Exodus 14

- Moses went back to Egypt and did what God told him to.
- Moses freed the Israelites from the evil Pharaoh.
- As they left Egypt, they camped beside the Red Sea.
- All of a sudden, they saw Pharaoh's army coming after them.
- They had no way of escape.
- Moses told the people to not be afraid, that God would fight for them.
- Moses stretched out his hand over the Red Sea, and it divided.
- The children of Israel walked across on dry land.
- When they reached the other side, they looked back and saw the Egyptians coming after them.
- Moses stretched out his hand over the Red Sea, and the waters came back.
- All the Egyptians drowned.

### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. How did Moses help the Israelites when he went back to Egypt?
2. Moses prayed to God for help. What miracle happened to help the Israelites to escape to freedom?
3. When the Egyptians tried to cross the sea, what happened to the water?
4. When is a time when God has done something for you or helped you with a tough problem?

Pray for children to have the protection of the Lord.

### DRAMA SCRIPT 76

Flossie is trying to recreate the parting of the Red Sea for a school project. God helps her discover the answer:

### ACTIVITY IDEAS

#### Red Sea Craft

Let each child have a piece of blue construction paper and tell them to turn it horizontally. Show them how to fold the paper by bringing each side of it and meeting them in the middle and making two creases. When the paper is opened, it should have three sections. Next, glue a strip of white or tan colored paper in the middle section of the three sections. Let the children use crayons to color the people walking across the dry land. Show them how to fold the blue flaps down to show the Red Sea, and then how when they open it up, parting the water and creating a walkway.

#### Red Sea Object Lesson

Take a pan of water and ask students if they can hold back the water. Let them try with a tongue depressor or their hands. Then put a transparent glass in the water. Show how the glass forms a wall that holds back the water. Talk about how God was able to push the water into walls with His mighty power.

### OBJECTIVE

Children will learn how Moses had many adventures with God. Moses' life was never boring. God always had Moses helping Him do something exciting.

### APPLICATION

Through learning how Moses had adventures with God, children see that life with God is never boring but exciting and fun.
