

Benevolence/Financial Help from Trinity Fellowship Process

Benevolence

- Person seeking help must be actively involved in some area of Trinity.
- Call the church and state that you are needing benevolence.
- You will be connected to that ministry and asked the following questions:
 - Are you involved at Trinity (verification needed if not a member)?
 - What are you needing?
- If food or clothing is needed, the church will make those arrangements.
- Trinity has a limited budget and will typically only consider the following areas to help:
 - Rent
 - Utilities
 - Other areas **may** be considered on an individual basis.
- Based on the individual's needs, an appointment may be made. Proof of need will be required, but will not necessarily secure an appointment. The oversight pastor will make the determination.

Financial

- Call the church and ask for the Stewardship Director.
- You will be required to complete paperwork, before you have an appointment.
- Once the paperwork has been completed and returned, you will be called to schedule a time to meet. If you are married, you will both need to meet together with the financial counselor.
